
### **REFLECTIONS FOR THE MONTH OF JUNE**

June begins with the feast of the body and blood of Christ usually known as Corpus Christi. It is now celebrated on the Sunday after Trinity Sunday. We recall that Jesus' command was to "take and eat and drink: do this in memory of me". We are reminded of this during the celebration of the Eucharist at Mass.

The Feast of the Sacred Heart of Jesus is on the 7 June. This day focuses on Jesus' love his acceptance of all of us and his forgiveness and generosity .

The Feast day of St Peter and St Paul is on the 29 June. Peter became the first Bishop of Rome and his faith would be a rock on which Jesus would build his Church upon.
