Any lost property which has not been claimed by the end of the month will be re-cycled.

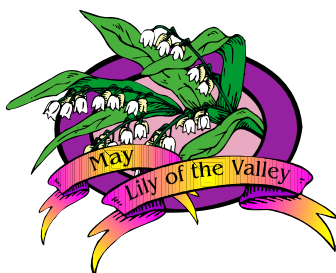
TEACHER2PARENTS TEXT MESSAGES
