The season of Lent

deepen our commitment to a way of life, rooted in our baptism. In our busy world, Lent provides us with an opportunity to pray more deeply, experience sorrow for what we've done and failed to do, and to be generous to those in need.

A time for Reflection

1st Sunday of Lent: Matthew 4:1-11 The devil tried to tempt Jesus to do something wrong, but even though Jesus was tired and hungry, He did what was right.

2nd Sunday of Lent: Matthew 17:1-9 Jesus' friends were really amazed when they saw Jesus transformed.

3rd Sunday of Lent: John 4: 5-42 Jesus tells a woman with whom He is speaking that she should ask for Living Water.

4th Sunday of Lent: John 4: 5-42 Jesus heals a man who was born blind.

5th Sunday of Lent: John 11: 3-45 Jesus raises Lazarus from the dead.
