All children will need to be collected from the Town Hall at the end of the concert.



HEALTH AND SAFETY

SAFEGUARDING

Please check the website for the new Safeguarding and Child Protection Policy. The policy will be available to view online shortly.

Our Policy states:

- Providing a safe environment for children to learn and develop in, including curriculum to provide children with the skills to keep themselves safe.
- Ensuring that all school staff are trained to recognise signs of child abuse and know how to report any concerns.
- Supporting pupils in accordance with his/her agreed child protection, child in need of a TAF (Team Around the family) Plan.
- Ensuring we practice safe recruitment processes to ensure that all staff and volunteers are employed by the school are suitable to work with children.
- Most importantly this guidance puts the needs of children and young people at its heart so the system fits and responds to you and not the other way around.
