A REMINDER

There has been an increasing trend for families to arrange holidays in term time. The law is quite clear on this topic and states that holiday leave in term time is at the discretion of the school and not an automatic entitlement.

SEPTEMBER INTAKE 2010

Reception

Children born between 01.09.05 and 31.08.06 are due to start school in September 2010. Please ensure that your child is registered, children are not automatically awarded a place if they are in Nursery or if they have an older sibling in school. The school cannot accept responsibility for the non registration of children.

Nursery

If your child was born between 01.09.06 and 31.08.07 then your child is eligible for a part time Nursery place. The closing date for registration for the Nursery is Friday 12 February 2010. Parents will be informed as to the outcome of the admissions committee decision by letter which will be posted before the Easter holiday.

ART SHIRTS

Please ensure that your child has an appropriate Art shirt in school - they are usually kept in their P.E. bags.

SCHOOL UNIFORM
