# St. Gregory's Reading Superheroes

Our Reading Superheroes each have a 'super power' linked to the Reading Domains. Children use these 'super powers', or skills, whilst reading and are taught these skills during Reading Comprehension sessions.

The logos for each Superhero will be used alongside Comprehension Questions for children to have a deeper understanding of the skills that they are using.





### <u>Dark Decoder</u>

KS1 – draw on knowledge of vocabulary to understand texts.

KS2 – give/explain the meaning of words in context





## **Rocket Retriever**

KS1 – identify/explain key aspects of fiction and non-fiction such as characters, events and key information

KS2 – retrieve and record information/identify key details from fiction and non -fiction





## **Summarise and Sequence Shadow**

KS1 – identify and explain the sequence of events in texts

KS2 – summarise main ideas from more than one paragraph





#### **Crimson Clue Hunter**

KS1 – make inferences from the text

KS2 – make inferences from the text/explain and justify inferences with evidence from the text





### **Phantom Predictor**

KS1 – predict what might happen on the basis of what has been read so far
KS2 – predict what might happen from details stated and implied





## **The Puzzler**

KS2 – identify/explain how information/narrative content is related and contributes to meaning as a whole





## **Word Wolf**

KS2 – identify/explain how meaning is enhanced through choice of words and phrases





## **Captain Comparison**

KS2 – make comparisons within the text
