Dear parents and carers of Year 4 pupils

On **Thursday 7th April 2022** Year 4 children will have a celebration day in recognition of those who have made their First Holy Communion and for all those children who have supported them on their faith journey through learning about the Sacraments.

The children in Year 4 are invited to come to school in their First Holy Communion clothes, we will take the opportunity on this day to take the traditional First Holy Communion group photograph. If your child did not make their First Holy Communion they can attend school in their own choice of party clothing. Please do check footwear and clothing is suitable for a day in school including playtimes.

We will have our usual weekly Mass led by Class 5. Following Mass, the children can change out of their First Holy Communion outfits into party clothes and we will have a year group celebration.

As part of the celebration we are asking each child to bring in some party food for themselves. This will be eaten during the afternoon, lunchboxes will need to be provided and school dinners will need to be booked in the usual way. Party food can include a treat, but please remember no nuts, fizzy drinks or glass bottles.

Please note we will ask that food is not shared due to the ever-increasing food allergies amongst children.
