Dear Parents and carers,

In Year 4, we will trial a new way of setting Home Learning for the children in preparation for the next academic year. We will be using a tool that the children are very familiar with called 'Purple Mash'. They already know how to log in and access their work as it is the same platform we use to teach computing in school and other cross-curricular themes.

The Home Learning expectation will remain the same for now and will consist of:

- Spellings
- Maths activity
- English activity

The greatest difference to what we currently ask for, is that none of these activities need to be manually handed in. All of the activities set will be electronically handed in through Purple Mash. If there is ever an occasion where the children need to hand something in physically, then a paper copy will be readily made available for each child should they need it.

Please bear with us and let us know if there any complications during this trial period – we are keen to make this work and are happy to receive feedback.

At the end of the summer term, we would be grateful for a more in-depth level of feedback by return of a questionnaire that we will circulate nearer the time.
