Key Vocabulary A large area of land that is made up of continent various countries e.g. Europe is a continent. England and Spain are countries in it. An area of land controlled by a single country government e.g. England is a country. The city that acts as the seat of capital city government in a country. Weather conditions in an area in general or climate over a long period of time. A very large area of sea. ocean An imaginary circle around Earth that equator divides it into 2 equal parts: the Northern and Southern Hemisphere. A half of the Earth: the equator divides hemisphere Earth into the Northern and Southern hemisphere. The number of people living in a particular population area e.g. country, city, etc. A coloured piece of material that is a flag symbol of a specific country. Very developed areas with many human urban features e.g. buildings, roads, etc.

Despite being a much larger country, <u>England's population is</u> <u>nearly double that of Australia</u>. This is because the climate in many areas of Australia is unsuitable to live in. The <u>seasons in</u> <u>Australia are opposite</u> to those in the Northern Hemisphere; when it is winter in Europe, it is summer in Australia.
