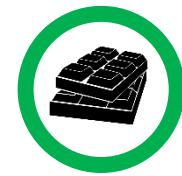

Key Vocabulary	
continent	A large area of land that is made up of various countries.

United Kingdom	A state that is made up of 4 countries: Scotland, England, Wales and Northern Ireland.
England	The country that we live in. Part of the United Kingdom.
Mexico	A country in the continent North America.
capital city	The city that acts as the seat of government in a country.
London	The capital city of the country England.
Mexico City	The capital city of the country Mexico.


