Dates for the diary and reminders:

Academic Year 2022-2023: Children starting in Years 1–6 will return to school on Wednesday 7th September, gates will be open from 8.45a.m. until 8.55 a.m. Please remember all children must be supervised in the playground in the mornings by the adult/adults who have accompanied them to school.

Children in classes 6,5 and 4 will enter and be dismissed each day via the door in the small playground on the Wigorn Road side of school.

Pre school and Reception Classes will enter via the Wigorn road playground also and go straight into their classrooms.

Classes 1 and 3 will enter into their classrooms via the external classroom doors by the arena in the larger playground.

Class 2 children will enter and be dismissed each day by the door on the ramp by the arena in the bigger playground.

Staff will be available to support families each morning until everyone settles into the new school year.

On Monday 12th September 2022 there will be a meeting for parents of children in Class 6 at 5pm, about the residential trip to Frank Chapman Residential Centre.
