**Dates for the diary and reminders:**

**Academic Year 2022-2023:** Children starting in Years 1–6 will return to school on **Wednesday 7<sup>th</sup> September**, gates will be open from 8.45a.m. until 8.55 a.m. Please remember all children must be supervised in the playground in the mornings by the **adult/adults who have accompanied them to school.**

**Children in classes 6,5 and 4 will enter and be dismissed each day via the door in the small playground on the Wigorn Road side of school.**

**Pre school and Reception Classes will enter via the Wigorn road playground also and go straight into their classrooms.**

**Classes 1 and 3 will enter into their classrooms via the external classroom doors by the arena in the larger playground.**

**Class 2 children will enter and be dismissed each day by the door on the ramp by the arena in the bigger playground.**

**Staff will be available to support families each morning until everyone settles into the new school year.**
