On Wednesday 7th Classes 1-6 commenced the new academic year in a very positive way.

On Friday 9th we met as a school community, Mr Hancox led us in an assembly of remembrance for Queen Elizabeth.



Dates for the diary and reminders:

Academic Year 2022-2023: Gates will be open from 8.45a.m. until 8.55 a.m. Please remember all children must be supervised in the playground in the mornings by the **adult/adults who have accompanied them to school.**

Children in classes 6,5 and 4 will enter and be dismissed each day via the door in the small playground on the Wigorn Road side of school.

Pre school and Reception Classes will enter via the Wigorn road playground also and go straight into their classrooms.

Classes 1 and 3 will enter into their classrooms via the external classroom doors by the arena in the larger playground.

Class 2 children will enter and be dismissed each day by the door on the ramp by the arena in the bigger playground.

Staff will be available to support families each morning until everyone settles into the new school year.

Monday 12th September 2022 there will be a meeting for **parents of children in Class 6 at 5pm**, about the residential trip to Frank Chapman Residential Centre.

The residential is planned for Monday 19th September -Friday 23rd September 2022

Tuesday 13th September 2022: Meet the staff. All parents are invited to attend school at 5pm for a meeting with class teachers where information about the coming school year will be shared.
