# Key dates and information

#### **Applications:**

- Open 17 July 2023
- Close **31 October 2023**
- Notification 1 March 2024

#### Some facts:

- It is NOT first come first served
- You can (and should) apply for up to 6 places.
- You apply to the council you live in. This includes if you are applying for a school in a neighbouring borough.
- Only list a grammar school as a preference if your child has sat and passed the entrance test (results 20 October 2023)
- Form cannot be changed once submitted.

# How to apply

- Check the admissions policy for each school
- Available via each schools website (check policies section)
- Check if your child meets the criteria
- Look out for any additional requirements
- For example Sandwell Academy require your child to sit a nonverbal reasoning test

- Click schools and learning
- Click apply for a school place
- DO NOT submit until you are 100% sure.

# Appealing a school place


# If you do not get the school you wanted:

- Accept the place you have been given, even if it is not the school you want.
- Download, complete and post appeals form (sandwell.gov.uk)
- or appeal the decision online (My Sandwell)

- You can only appeal for a place at a school that you put on your preference list
- To appeal for Sandwell Academy, contact them directly
- To appeal for a school outside of Sandwell you will need to contact the relevant local authority
